## Campaign Countdown ...

We have a little less than a month to go in our Capital Campaign. There is plenty left to be done; but it is encouraging that as this is written, 102 donors have pledged **\$768,500** (or 25.6% of our campaign goal)! We fully expect many more parishioners will give to our drive.

Dozens of volunteers are still working on this project. Visiting fellow parishioners and asking them to join the many others who are supporting this effort and have made their own commitment. If you are called for a visit, please try to make yourself available to the volunteers. We know that the sacrificial giving of money can be difficult. Our dedicated volunteers are your fellow parishioners and are calling on behalf of Father Frazier and the parish for the good of St. Joseph-on-Carrollton Manor. The new church is very important for the future of our parish, for our children, for ourselves, and for those who come after us.

Please think about what you can do to support this important campaign. Remember that pledges are payable over a period of three to five years. When you are asked to contribute, we are asking you to join other parishioners in supporting your spiritual home – St. Joseph Parish.

And remember too: If you give a gift of \$2,000 or more (payable over three to five years), you are eligible for a leaf or rock on the Tree of Life. A gift of \$2,000 breaks down to \$1.83 a day over 3 years. What can you pledge?



## Envelope Changes

When you receive your offertory envelope packet for June, you'll notice that the blue "Land and Building Fund" envelope has been replaced by the cream "Honoring Our Past, Building Our Future Together" envelope. You may use these envelopes for pledge payments or for any gift you want to make toward building a new church. Your check should be made out to "**St. Joseph's Capital Campaign**". If you have made a pledge (thank you!) this will ensure your payment is credited toward your pledge. When you give generously each month using the envelope, you will help your parish realize the dream of building a new church on the land that your past contributions helped purchase.
