Campaign breakdown ...

The Special Phase of the Capital Campaign was launched this past week. 162 campaign packets were mailed out asking for pledges of \$3,000 over three to five years, which works out to about \$1.60 a day. The campaign volunteers will attempt to call all Special Phase families to answer any questions you may have about the new church or the campaign. If you have received the packet please respond as soon as you have considered the request from Father Frazier. We would like to receive all pledges by the end of the month of May.

If you have not received a visit or a packet in the mail you will still have an opportunity to participate in this campaign during our in pew weekend to be held June 10 and 11.
