We are looking forward to a new year of Faith Formation in September and are excited to be gathering in-person once again. We're working to ensure that we will have a safe, faith filled experience for your family.

GRADES K-5 COMPONENTS - HYBRID PROGRAM

Pflaum Gospel Weeklies: Pflaum Gospel weeklies will be used in the classroom and at home. Children will meet in-person two Sundays a month from 9:30-10:20 am. The rest of the lessons will be delivered at home by parents; training will be provided. Zoom sessions will be offered on Wednesdays at 6:00 pm for those students that aren't able to gather on Sundays.

Family Life: Our Family Life component, which is required by the Archdiocese and important in forming our children in faith and in the teachings of the church, will be incorporated into the program and delivered by catechists in the classroom.

Family Sessions: Our community component for the program will be monthly on a Saturday (with some exceptions) starting with the 4:30 pm Mass. We will be gathering with our faith family for hands on activities on the liturgical celebrations.

GRADES 6-8

Middle school students will meet on Mondays from 7:00-8:15 pm and will be using the [Lifeteen Edge Program](#).

Grades 9-12

High School students will meet on Sundays from 12:00 –1:15 pm and will be using the [Lifeteen Program](#).

SACRAMENT PREP

For those preparing to receive the Sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist, materials to prepare the children at home will be provided to the parents. We will be gathering children and parents at church for five enrichment sessions and a retreat with hands on activities for each one of these sacraments. Confirmation students will gather on Sundays at noon and for a retreat.
